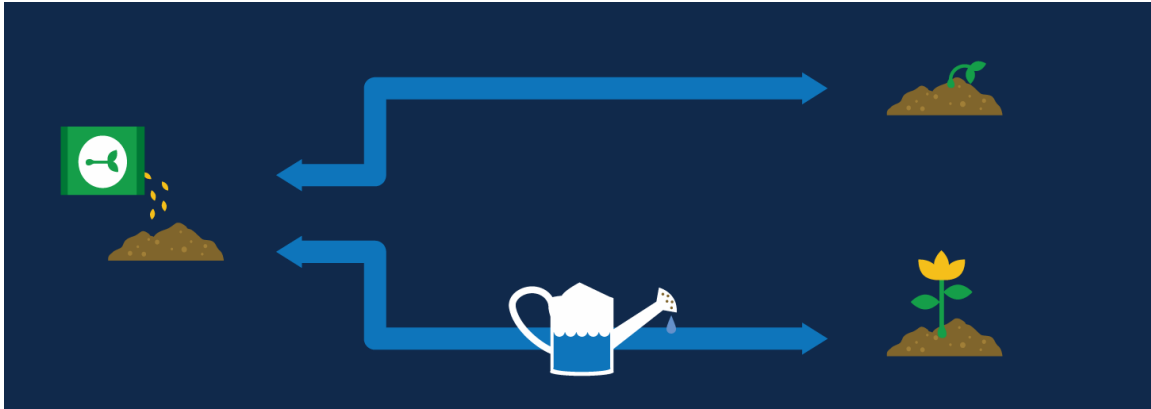




## Leadership & Responsibility

*To build your Leadership & Responsibility portfolio you can:*

- Become involved in a decision-making group at school or in your community.
- Voice your opinion in the school or local newspaper.
- Read a book about someone you think represents a true leader. Explain why this person is a leader.
- Get involved in a school or local community issue. Attend meetings and participate in activities.
- Interview someone in a leadership position. Represent what you learned from the interview.
- Speak at a faculty or school board meeting concerning an issue that is important to students.
- Explore leadership *without* responsibility. What does this look like? When do you think this has been demonstrated?
