Many games and ideas can be found online. Below are a few ideas to get you started.

Infomercial

Gather a variety of ordinary household objects. This might include a pen, napkin, or bowl. Give each person a few minutes to think about their product and how they would sell it. Each person has two minutes to present an infomercial about their wonderful product and why consumers should purchase it.

Mold It

This game is a twist on charades. You will need ordinary modeling clay or playdough for this game. One person creates a list of a variety of nouns. For example, easy words might include dog, apple, and pencil. More challenging words might include tree, taco, and unicycle. Divide your family/group into two teams. Take turns pulling out a word from the pile and sculpting that noun for the members of your guess. You have two minutes to sculpt while the rest of the team shouts out answers. Continue the game until the laughter stops!

Eyes Closed

This is a fun drawing game with a twist – the person drawing must keep his or her eyes closed. Create a list that includes a variety of scenarios and terms. This might include house, jack in the box, baseball game, making dinner, swimming in the ocean, etc. Divide your family/group into two teams. Take turns pulling out a scenario from the pile and drawing it for the members of your team to guess. Remember the person drawing must keep his or her eyes closed. You have two minutes to draw while the rest of the team shouts out answers. Continue the game until the laughter stops!
